Our location and the journey getting here

On the east coast of Tasmania, Picnic Island is around two and a half hours by road from Hobart and Launceston airports. Alternatively a seaplane or helicopter from Hobart is a 30-minute trip. All allow for the dramatic unfolding of the Tasmanian landscape.
